



## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### FEES

ADMISSION FEE — Rs. 500/-  
MONTHLY FEE — Rs. 300/-

1. The person joining for the first time shall pay both admission and monthly fee for the first month.
2. Monthly fees should be paid on or before 10th of every month failing which a fine of Rs. 25 /- will be collected along with the monthly fees.
3. Fees once paid is Non-refundable under any circumstance.

### AGE LIMIT

1. The applicant shall be not less than 5 years of age. The admission is solely at the discretion of the Y.K.A Administration.
2. There is no maximum age limit for admission.

### UNDERTAKING FOR PARENTS / GUARDIAN (In Case of Minors)

I have no objection to my son / daughter join in the Martial arts classes and will not hold this Association responsible for any accident that may happen to his / her within the Martial arts classes as accident of his / her negligence.

### GENERAL RULES

1. Yuddhagyan Karate Do Association reserves the right of admission.
2. Student shall wear the karate dress approved by the institution.
3. Nails should be clearly cut.
4. Discipline should be maintained during teaching hours.
5. Student shall not demonstrate, practice and teach this martial arts outside the karate school/dojo, in the absence of his/ her chief instructor or without the direct supervision of senior deputed by the chief instructor either in places where such classes of instruction conducted or outside.
6. A compulsory attendance of 20 classes a month is essential failing which he/she shall not be eligible for the periodical grading tests.
7. Belt test will be held after 3 months of regular attendance. A nominal fee will be charged for belt test.
8. The decision of the Chief Examiner / President / Secretary General (Y.K.A) shall be final and irrevocable on all matters of promotions, Warnings, dismissals from the Karate classes on charge of misbehavior, misuse of karate, indiscipline, provocative acts etc.
9. The instructor or the Chief instructor / President / Secretary General (Y.K.A) shall not be either involved or referred to in any complaint to the police or otherwise in the event of any student directly or indirectly has acted in or have used the techniques of karate either alone or in association with others to cause subversion of society or cause pain or injury / invalidity of temporary or permanent nature to any individual or private or public property.
10. The art is imparted to each individual at his / her own risk. Though all precautions would be observed no claim of any sort would be made on the individual / Instructors / President / Secretary General (Y.K.A) / Institution for any accident which may result in pain, injury, fractures, dislocations, partial / full disablement, unconsciousness of temporary or permanent nature, etc.
